Referrals are welcome for individuals living with:

Progressive Conditions

Neurodegenerative conditions including Motor Neurone Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Huntington's Disease, brain tumours, Parkinson's Disease and other neurological disorders.

Sudden Onset Conditions

Traumatic and acquired brain injury including those sustained through trauma, anoxia, stroke, tumour, virus or infection. Spinal cord injury (Southampton only)

Dementia

Pick's disease, Frontotemporal Dementia, Korsakoff's Syndrome and other early-onset dementias.

Neuro-palliative / End of Life Care

A neurological disorder with end of life care due to the progressive nature of conditions.

Presenting symptoms supported and specialist care provided includes:

Complex Physical Disabilities

- spasticity & postural management
- supported nutrition & hydration including PEG management
- continence & personal care
- mobility impairments
- skin integrity issues/concerns
- swallowing difficulties (dysphagia) requiring modified diets and supported feeding

Communication & Cognitive Impairment

- moderate to severe cognitive impairment
- communication difficulties
- memory problems, disorientation & confusion
